Getting Here / Accessibility

by public transport

Tram stop Löwenbräu (tram lines 4, 13 or 17).

  The closest public transport stop, Löwenbräu tram stop, is barrier-free for visitors with limited mobility. With the ZürichCard, travel to Löwenbräukunst with all public transport is free of charge.

  A staircase with 14 steps leads to the Löwenbräukunst main entrance (Limmatstrasse 270). The barrier-free entrance is at Limmatstrasse 268 (Elevator, Level C). All levels of the building are accessible by lift and all the galleries are wheelchair accessible.

  Limited parking including two disabled parking spaces is available in the courtyard of the Löwenbräukunst-Areal.

Nils Amadeus Lange *Der Umbau* Performance Migros Museum für Gegenwartskunst – Level 0

As part of the exhibition *Accumulation*, Nils Amadeus Lange's new work *Der Umbau (The Conversion)* approaches the work *Homes from Homes II* (2000-2001) by the artist group Art & Language from the collection of the Migros Museum für Gegenwartskunst.

The conceptual installation consists of reworked versions of earlier works by the artist group as well as other works from the collection. Variations in size, color, technique and text fragments create copies and parodies that reflect the relationship between original and reproduction and the mechanisms of the art world.
